

## **REALTOR® OF THE YEAR AWARD**

Current President and/or President-Elect are ineligible to receive this award. The candidate must display distinguished service in the promotion and advancement of the interests and the ideals of the real estate profession. The candidate must demonstrate an ongoing involvement in real estate activities **(GRAR, WCR, NYSAR, NAR or otherwise)** exemplifying an ambassador of the Association. The candidate must have community interests. The candidate held REALTOR® status for the past consecutive three (3) years or more.

### **Fran Henty Golden Rule Award**

In 1980, Francis Henty became a REALTOR® Member of the Greater Rochester Association of REALTORS®. His office was located on Maple Street in Dansville, N.Y. Distance did not keep Fran from serving on committees. He was Chairman of the Professional Standards Committee for many years as well as the Membership Committee. He was the first non-resident member to sit on the Board of Directors.

His distinguished service to GRAR (then known as the Real Estate Board of Rochester) is reflective of his commitment to hard work and excellence. His accomplishments and honors, innovations and involvement were the milestones of his life and his career. He was proud to be a REALTOR® and he always went the extra mile to observe the spirit of the Code of Ethics and bring honor to the real estate industry.

In 1989, Fran Henty passed away. The Association wanted to do something special to honor his memory. In 1990, the “Fran Henty Golden Rule Award” was established for members who “go that extra mile” in their real estate dealings as well as their personal lives.
