Steps to Obtaining a Real Estate Salesperson's License

- Successfully complete the 75-Hour New York State Department of State approved Salesperson's Licensing Course and pass the required course exam with a minimum of 70%. There is a requirement of a minimum of 90% course hour attendance, which means you may only miss 7.5 hours of class. You will be responsible for learning the material covered during your absence. YOU DO NOT NEED A SPONSORING BROKER TO TAKE THE 75-HOUR COURSE.
- Successfully complete the New York State
 Department of State's Licensing exam with a
 minimum of 70%. This exam is currently
 administered every other Tuesday (except
 holidays) at the Finger Lakes DDSO, located
 at 620 Westfall Road. You must register in
 advance for this exam.
- Apply for a Salesperson's License
 - Must have taken the 75-Hour class and passed course exam
 - Must have passed NY state exam
 - Be sponsored by a NYS Licensed Real Estate Broker

TRANSFERS

Tuition transfers ARE allowed, however tuition may be transferred only once within a six (6) month period. Students agree that any refund requested on transferred tuition is subject to a 20% service charge.

REFUNDS

- A student's actions resulting in permanent dismissal from the course.
